LEARNING AND SUPPORT TEAM

NAPLAN

Congratulations to all of our students and families for their calm approach to NAPLAN. Results will come out later in the year and we will provide a parent working shop around interpreting these results.

PARENT EXCURSION

Academic Winter Uniform - Terms 2 and 3



- Shirt: Logoed short sleeved polo predominantly green
- Jumper: Logoed green jumper
- Trousers: Boys black elastic waist trousers
- Socks: White ankle socks
- Shoes: Black, leather, lace up, buckled school shoes or black joggers
- Optional: Logoed sport jacket over the green jumper

Academic Winter Uniform – Terms 2 and 3



- > Shirt: Logoed short sleeved polo predominantly green
- > Jumper: Logoed green jumper
- Trousers: Girls black elastic waist trousers
- Socks: White ankle socks
- Shoes: Black, leather, lace up, buckled school shoes or black joggers
- Optional: Logoed sport jacket over the green jumper

OR

- > Dress: Green and white check
- Jumper: Logoed green jumper
- Stockings: Thick opaque green stockings or tights no footless tights
- Shoes: Black, leather, lace up school shoes or black joggers

Sport Uniform – ONLY to be worn Fridays



- Shirt: Logoed short sleeve polo predominantly white
- Shorts (Summer): Logoed black sport shorts
